All pupils can continue to ensure they keep their learning going by doing some of the following:

- Use their Glow login to access learning tiles from their 'Launch Pad'.
- Use their Education City login to access several learning activities which will be updated by class teachers and stored in their class folders.
- P2 -7 pupils have a Sumdog login where they can continue to work through maths activities. Parents of P1 pupils can register their child for an account as many of these providers will be giving free access while schools are closed.
- All pupils can use their termly newsletter which can be downloaded from the school app or website to access learning around the targets set for each curricular area.
- The 'Pupil Zone' section of the school website has links to a range of learning tiles which will allow pupils to continue learning.
- P1-3 pupils could download the 'Bookbug App' from the Scottish Book Trust which has a range of songs and rhymes to access. All pupils should continue to read daily using a range of media and favourite reading materials.
- Use the list of common words and stage 1, 2 and 3 phoneme lists that can be downloaded from Twinkl or the school website class area to keep spelling and phonics practice going. Pupils can use the 'Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check' method to practise the words.
- Using board games like Monopoly, Snakes and Ladders, Scrabble and Ludo will keep skills like problem solving, counting and reading active.
- Use the house or surrounding outdoor areas if possible, to continue learning opportunities and physical activity.
- Topmarks is another site where children can continue their literacy and numeracy work.
- Children can type 'Be Internet Legends' into their search bar and this will allow them to continue using the school resource we use for online safety.
- Twinkl have opened their platform for all to use which has many learning packs and resources to use.
- The Newsround site is a great way for the children to keep up to date with current news and also gives access to a range of clips, games and quizzes.
- Pobble365 is a site where pupils can continue their writing using the ideas found here.
- Cosmic Kids has interactive videos and links to a variety of learning opportunities
