

Dear Parent/Carer

Parental Reporting and Engagement

As you will now be aware this academic year is progressing very differently to anything we have ever had before and will continue along this way for some time to come.

Like you, we are disappointed that we have not been able to continue with the variety of parent/carer engagements we are used to offering that allow you to visit the school to hear about your child's learning and to see the learning environment we all work in.

We do understand though, that this session will involve a number of different measures to ensure the safety of all and we would like to share with you how we will continue to provide you with information around your child's learning and progress in school and alternative methods of communication across the school year.

Pupil Interim Report

In October your child will bring home their school interim report which will give you a brief indication of how they are doing in their personal and social development.

Settling In Report

In November your child will bring home another report this time detailing the information you would normally receive during our Parents' Evening. This will give you an outline of their general progress and effort, social development and behaviour and next steps in literacy and numeracy.

Learning Folios

Due to current restrictions and a reduction in items being brought into schools, as an alternative to the 'Snapshot Jotters', each class will complete a folio of work in October, December, February and May and this work will be sent home to share a snapshot of your child's learning. We are not asking for these folios to be sent back and can be left in a safe place at home for 72 hours before being looked at in line with the current guidance around quarantining.

Year End Report

As in usual circumstances, all children will receive their end of year report around March/April time and this will include details of their progress across the session.

Throughout the session we would encourage you to continue to use the school office email and phone to share any information with us and school staff will also be in contact with individual families across the session if further discussions are required.
