<p>Behaviour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Shouting out</li><li>• Disrupting other children's learning</li><li>• Not completing class work due to miss-behaviour</li><li>• Lack of concentration</li></ul>	<p>Behaviour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Consistent Level 1 behaviour</li><li>• Hurting and/or annoying others in class</li><li>• Use of inappropriate language</li><li>• Being disrespectful to class teacher and arguing back when spoken to</li></ul>	<p>Behaviour</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Consistent Level 2 behaviour</li><li>• Physical attacks or fighting</li></ul>
<p>Staged Responses</p> <p>1 Verbal warning 2 In class sanctions</p>	<p>Staged Responses</p> <p>1 Pupil sent to PT for discussion after playtime 2 Pupil will be asked to stay in for a reflective playtime</p>	<p>Staged Responses</p> <p>1 Pupil is removed from classroom and sent to office (accompanied)</p> <p>2 Head Teacher will discuss behaviour with pupil and parent is informed by letter</p> <p>3 Pupil may begin a weekly behaviour chart and this will be reviewed at the end of the week</p> <p>4 If no improvement in behaviour parent/carer will be invited to a meeting with school staff</p>
