MATHS AND NUMERACY

- Using groups of 2, 5 and 10 to work out Multiplication and Division problems
- Using tally marks, pictograms and bar graphs to record and analyse information
- Understanding numbers to 20between, less than, more than, fewest, most

At home you could

- Practise by sorting sweets, small toys etc into 2s, 5s and 10s
- Make a survey of people you knowhair colour, eye colour, favourite crisp flavour etc

LITERACY

- Engage with non-fiction texts and use contents and index pages
- Take simple notes from text, audio and video clips
- Recognise and use nouns, adjectives and verbs

At home you could

- Share new facts you have gained from reading non-fiction
- Summarise main points from stories

- Healthy Eating a balanced plate
- Where do foods come from?
- Food labels

At home you could

- Bake bread
- Try to make a meal from scratch you would normally buy ready made

- The Holy Mass

At home you could

- Say a special Hail Mary each day throughout the month or try a decade of the Rosary
- Talk about St Louise
- Engage with a mass online or practise parts of Mass together at home
- Share some favourite hymns
