



In Primary 5 our learning will include

MATHS AND NUMERACY

- Estimate, measure and order length, weight, area and volume.
- Use coordinates and right angles/45° angles to describe journeys.

At home you could

- Explore different units of measure e.g. weight in food products, volume of different liquids and the length of objects.

LITERACY

- Using evidence from texts in class to answer a range of comprehension questions.
- In writing, use paragraphs to separate events/ideas/facts.
- When engaged in debate, can put across own opinion accurately and can listen to and acknowledge the opinion of others whether agreed or disagreed with.

At home you could

- Discuss yours and your child's viewpoints on different topics.
- When reading together, ask your child for evidence as to why the character has changed, or on the setting or the overall theme of the book/chapter.

HEALTH AND WELLBEING

Achieving

- Recognising their worth as individuals by identifying positives about themselves and achievements
- Understand factors that may influence their motivation for success

At home you could

- Discuss different positive traits that your child has and help them to choose to a positive role model

RELIGIOUS EDUCATION

- Learning about the Seven Sacraments and how they strengthen relationships

At home you could

- Discuss and share memories of when you received your Sacraments and reflect on those your child has received thus far.

ACROSS THE CURRICULUM

Science - Materials

- Investigate and record chemical changes to the properties of materials which are irreversible e.g. cooking, rusting etc.
- Explore filtration

At home you could

- Investigate chemical changes that happen in the home e.g. boiling an egg
