

# Mnemonics

Make up a sentence for your spelling word to help you remember the order of the letters.

For Example:

NEST - Neil Eats Sugar Treats



# Syllables

Clap out long words to split them up into parts.

For Example:

In - ter - na - tion - al

Ex - cla - ma - tion



# Back Writing

Help a friend write their words!

Write the word on their back slowly and see if they can guess what it is!



# Whiteboards

Write a word on the board. Then try it with your eyes closed!

Ask a friend to take away a letter and see if you can put it back.



# Look For The Hard Bit

Look at your spelling word - split it up.  
Focus on the bit that seems hard.

Write your spelling word, concentrating on  
the hard bit.

Write the word in the sand. Focus on  
the shape of each letter.

Then, try to make the word again  
with your eyes closed.

Look at your word.

Can you think of other words that are  
spelt in the same way?

Look for a spelling pattern  
in your word.

bottle  
kettle  
settle

can within 1 minute.

Get a friend to time you.



# Magnetic Letters

Practice making your words with the letters.

Then ask a friend to jumble them up.

See if you can re-arrange them

to spell the word correctly.



# Rainbow Writing

Write your spelling word in as many different colours of the rainbow as you can.

Make a rainbow shape with your word.
