

Primary 1– Please find below some activities to do across the week

Literacy Numeracy	 This week's common words are: had, see, has Pick one word and write as many times as you can in a minute. You could use pens, chalk, paint etc. Repeat for the other 2 words. Write a sentence or two about your week in your jotter. Remember to try your best to sound out your words. It doesn't need to be perfect! Phonics – explore the sound 'ee'. Play the games in your education city class folder, find the green ee and place on your phonics board, make words – green, seen, been, meet, look out for more ee words in your own books at home. Have a look at the oxford owls ebooks on the website https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page Ask an adult to register then search for books by level, book band, red. Have a go at counting in 2s. 0,2,4,6,8,10 Write out the number pattern
	 Use the number cards in your home pack or ask an adult to write the numbers to 20 on a piece of paper, cut into individual cards, give them a shuffle and put back into the correct order. Complete the maths games in your Education City Class folder.
