

Primary 1– Please find below some activities to do across the week

Literacy	 This week's common words are: play, no, look Pick a word and copy onto paper/your jotter/ your phonics board. Ask an adult to play some music for you to dance to. When they stop the music write the word. (Like musical chairs, try to stop the music so your child gets to write the word several times). Pick a different word each day. Write a sentence or two about a book you have read. Remember to try your best to sound out your words. It doesn't need to be perfect! Phonics – explore the sound 'oo. Play the games in your education city class folder, find the green oo and place on your phonics board, make words – wood, good, food, and look out for more oo words in your own books at home. Have a look at the oxford owls ebooks on the website https://www.oxfordowl.co.uk/for-home/find-a-book/library-page Ask an adult to register then search for books by level, book band, red.
Numeracy	 Have a go at counting in 10s 0,10,20,30,40,50,60,70,80,90,100
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	 Pick 3 of your toys. Can you put them in 2 bundles to show the story of 3?

	1+2=3 3+0=3
	Can you make any subtraction sums?
	Complete the maths games in your Education City Class folder.
Music	 Have a go at logging in to Charanga music. Have a go at the home session- Big Bear Funk. You could even use some of the music here for your spelling game.
RE	During the month of May we devote our prayers to Mary. Perhaps at home you could
	pick a special place to make your own May altar. You could use a statue or draw a
	picture of Mary, add some flowers and if you have rosary beads you could place them
	here too. Try to say a Hail Mary as part of your daily prayers.
PE	 Use Jumpstart Jonny, PE with Joe, Cosmic Kids Yoga, Go Noodle to do PE indoors Play outdoors if you have a garden and try to go for a daily walk (remember to follow social distancing rules)
