Primary 1– Please find below some activities to do across the week

Literacy	 No new common words this week. This will give you a chance to practise the words you have already learnt. Perhaps you could write some words and hide them around your house. Challenge your family to find them and read them to you. Now ask them to hide words for you to find and read to them. Write a sentence or two about your favourite character this could be from a book, tv or film). Remember to try your best to sound out your words. It doesn't need to be perfect! Draw a picture too. Phonics – explore the sound 'ck'. Play the games in your education city class folder, find the green ck and place on your phonics board, make words – back, sack, snack, track, look out for more ck words in your own books at home. Reading – Collins Big cat has made their ebooks available for free during the current lockdown. You will need to logon using the user name and password provided on their website. You could read the red levels books and may even wish to try some yellow level too. https://collins.co.uk/pages/big-cat-ebooks
Numeracy	Complete the maths games in your Education City Class folder.
Numeracy	 Position and movement – try to play games and make use of the vocabulary of position such as over, under, beside, above, inside, outside, on, through, and around. Perhaps you could ask someone to challenge you using a toy or a ball. E.g. Put the ball around your waist, under your foot, beside the table, over your head, inside a box etc
RE	Try to join in the daily Angelus provided by the Motherwell diocese
