Primary 1– Please find below some activities to do across the week –

Literacy	This week's common words are — him all came Have a go at finding the words in books at home or by using books online by using websites such as Oxford Owls or Collins Big Cats.
	Play 'swat the word' - write the words out on small bits of paper/post it notes. Ask someone in your family to call out a word, find the word and swat it (you can use your hand instead of a fly swatter).
	 Phonics – explore the sound 'oy'. Play the games in your education city class folder, find the green oy and place on your phonics board, make words – toy,
	 boy, joy. Look out for more oy words in your own books at home. Use BBC iPlayer to watch 'The Highway Rat' https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b09kkt1k/the-highway-rat
	If you were the hero in this story, what would you do to stop the Highway Rat? Can you make a wanted poster for the Highway Rat, listing his name, what he looks like and his crimes?
Numeracy	 Complete the maths games in your Education City Class folder. This week I would like you to practise sorting your number cards into odd and even numbers. Remember even numbers can make pairs and are the numbers
	we say when counting in 2s (0, 2, 4, 6, 8, 10,). To help with this you could watch the following Number blocks episode- https://www.bbc.co.uk/iplayer/episode/b08r2l4d/numberblocks-series-2-odds-and-evens
	 Is your door number odd or even? Use your jotter – write the odd numbers in blue and the even numbers in red.
RE	 Continue to make use of the children's liturgy resources provided by Motherwell diocese on YouTube (DOM RE) https://www.youtube.com/channel/UCXh7oANVTvEkoby3IGPJQgg What makes you special? Write/draw about the unique qualities you have. Think about the kind of person you are and what you are really good at? Ask your family to help you. Can you tell your family about the fabulous qualities they have?
