Literacy

Phonological Awareness – We have been learning many rhymes and talking about words that rhyme (sound the same at the end). At home, say rhymes together – which one is your favourite?

Reading – We are enjoying hearing stories and talking about them. At home read a book together. Talk about your favourite part of the story.

Writing – We are practising writing our own names with a focus on using a capital letter for the first letter and lower case letters for all the others. At home – try writing your name using lots of different things such as pencils, pens, chalk/paint etc. You could also use the activity on the seesaw class app.

Numeracy

In class, we are practising saying numbers from 0 to 30. We are also trying to start and stop at given numbers such as starting at 5 and stopping at 15. At home you could try to start and stop from numbers given by your grown up.

Health And Wellbeing
