Literacy

Phonics – This week we have been learning about the sounds 'a' and 't'.

Have a look at home for objects that start with these letters. (You could add a photo to your seesaw journal if you wish). There are some games in your education city homework folder to help you learn these sounds.

Reading – We are looking at pictures and how they can be used to help us tell the story. As you are reading together this week, ask your child to tell you about the pictures in the books. If you are able to, sign up for a free account on oxford owls website

– search for the book 'In The Sky' ask your child to use the pictures to make up the story.

Writing – Have a go at writing our new letter sounds 'a' and 't'.

You can use pencils, pens, chalk etc. There is also a little activity you can use on Seesaw if you wish.

Numeracy

In class, we are learning about 2D shapes. Can you spot any circles, triangles, squares or rectangles at home or when you are out and about?

Talk about how you know which shape they are – by counting the sides, corners etc.

Activities to support this are also on Education City and Seesaw.

Health And Wellbeing

In class, we have heard a story about an alien who has developed a good growth mindset by not giving up when he was making a dress. Talk at home about a time you learned something new. What helped you to be successful?

In class, we have been learning about the Holy Family. Ask your child to tell you about Jesus, Mary and Joseph. We are learning that we are all part of God's family and that God is 'Our Father'. Pray the 'Our Father' together as a family.
