Literacy

Phonics – This week we have been learning about the sounds 's' and 'i'.

Have a look at home for objects that start with these letters. (You could add a photo to your seesaw journal if you wish). There are some games in your education city homework folder to help you learn these sounds.

Reading – We are looking at pictures and how they can be used to help us tell the story. As you are reading together this week, ask your child to tell you about the pictures in the books. If you are able to, sign up for a free account on oxford owls website https://home.oxfordowl.co.uk/reading/free-ebooks/

 search for the books 'The Haircut' and 'The Lost Teddy'. Ask your child to use the pictures to make up the story.

Writing – Have a go at writing our new common words – a, at, the, I, is, it. You can use pencils, pens, chalk etc.

Numeracy

Practise counting forwards to 30 and backwards from 20.

Give your child a small collection of objects and ask them to count them.

Have a go at writing numbers 0 - 10. You may wish to use the activity on Seesaw for this.

Health And Wellbeing

In class, we are continuing our work on developing a growth mindset. At home talk about a time you didn't give up. Talk about something you would like to learn or get better at.

Religious Education

In class, we have been learning about belonging to our school community. Ask your child to tell you the names of some of the people who help them at school.
