Literacy

Phonics – New sounds 'p' and 'n'

- look for the letters in books or when out and about
- talk about words that start with the sound.
- add the sounds to the alphabet strip on your phonics board
- make words using the sounds –
 pin pan nip nap
- play games in education city homework section

Reading – Common words – use your own books at home to try to spot the common words we have been learning –

a, at, the, I, is, it

Writing – practise writing your new sounds (formation video on Seesaw app), use rainbow writing (a different colour for each letter) to write your common words.

Numeracy

This week we have been thinking about comparing sizes. At home, compare objects and try to use vocabulary such as – big, small, short, tall, and long. You could also try to ask questions such as, 'Which is the tallest? Which one is shorter?'

Play a game that involves taking turns. Try to encourage the people you are playing with and congratulate the winner.
