



Primary 3 – Please find below some activities to do this week, 27 April.

Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• This week's spelling words are: Capital Letters: through, sing, morning, colour, kind; Full Stops: out, now, new.• Write out words 3 times in rainbow writing and choose 3 to write a sentence with. Challenge – use more than one of the spelling words in a sentence!• French – revise numbers to 20. Use Education City to help.• Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Talk to an adult about what you have read. Write about the main character or setting.• Complete some of the Literacy work on Education City, either Capital Letters or Full Stops folder.
Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Look around the house for 3D shapes and record them in your jotter. How many faces, edges and corners do they have?• Ask your mum/dad to play shops. Take turns at being the shopper and shop keeper. Use coins to make the amounts. Challenge - work out change they should receive.• Practise the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.• Complete some of the Maths activities on Education City – remember to click on CLASSWORK.
ICT	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Go on to Sumdog for 10 minutes every day if you can – try spelling and grammar activities on it too.• Try Nessie typing (link was on twitter last week) or BBC Dancemat Typing.
