Literacy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• This week's spelling words are: Capital Letters: put, different, light, sentence, stop; Full Stops: one, first, little.</li><li>• Write out words 3 times in fancy writing and choose 3 to write a sentence with. Challenge – use more than one of the spelling words in a sentence!</li><li>• Friday 8<sup>th</sup> May is VE Day. Find out why we remember this day and write a few sentences in your jotter about it.</li><li>• Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Tell an adult about the main character.</li><li>• SLLC Libraries have set a challenge – create a fact file for your favourite author containing at least 3 interesting facts and draw a picture of them. Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Use a clock to tell the time to half past eg 10 past 3, 20 past 7 etc.</li><li>• Write down the months of the year and seasons in order.</li><li>• Practise the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.</li><li>• Complete the Time activities on Education City – remember to click on CLASSWORK.</li></ul>
ICT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Go on to Sumdog for 10 minutes every day if you can – try spelling and grammar activities on it too.</li><li>• Use Google Interlands to learn more about internet safety.</li></ul>
