## Primary 3 – Please find below some activities to do this week, 11<sup>th</sup> May.

Literacy	<ul> <li>This week's spelling words are: Capital Letters: list, most, must, high, late;</li> <li>Full Stops: had, see, has.</li> <li>Write out words 3 times in pyramid writing and choose 3 to write a sentence with. Challenge – use more than one of the spelling words in a sentence!</li> <li>Plan Sports Day 2020 - see the attached sheet.</li> <li>Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Tell an adult about the setting.</li> <li>Complete some of the Literacy work on Education City, either Capital Letters or Full Stops folder.</li> </ul>
Numeracy	<ul> <li>Use a clock to tell the time to half past eg 10 past 3, 20 past 7 etc.</li> <li>Sumdog competition.</li> <li>Sing the 2, 3, 4, 5 and 10 times tables.</li> <li>Complete the Time activities on Education City – remember to click on CLASSWORK.</li> </ul>
ICT	<ul><li>Spelling and grammar activities on Sumdog.</li><li>Use Google Interlands to learn more about internet safety.</li></ul>
RE	<ul> <li>Join in with Motherwell Diocese daily Angelus Challenge and say this special prayer every day in May <u>https://youtu.be/P2Lw3p1Z1pw</u></li> <li>Saturday was St Louise feast day. Write 3 facts about St Louise and sing the hymn to St Louise.</li> </ul>
PE	<ul> <li>Use PE with Joe, Cosmic Kids Yoga or Jumpstart Johnny to do PE indoors.</li> <li>Play outdoors as much as you can.</li> </ul>
Other things to do	<ul> <li>Visit <u>www.glasgowsciencecentre.org</u> They are online at 10am every day.</li> <li>Try to log into Charanga Music and explore it (login is in Home Learning Pack)</li> <li>Watch Newsround and choose some BBC Bitesize programmes to watch.</li> <li>Make your bed every morning this week.</li> <li>French – revise numbers to 20 and Greetings – bonjour, salut etc. Use Education City to help.</li> </ul>
