Challenge – use more than one of the spelling words in a sentence!• Plan Sports Day 2020 - see the attached sheet.• Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Tell an adult about the setting.• Complete some of the Literacy work on Education City, either Capital Letters or Full Stops folder.
