St Louise Primary - School Closure Guidance

Primary 3 – Please find below some activities to do this week, 18th May.

Literacy	 This week's spelling words are: Capital Letters: revision week – practice all your words especially the ones you find tricky; Full Stops: play, no, look. Write out (tricky) words 3 times in bubble writing and choose 3 to write a sentence with. Challenge – use more than one of the spelling words in a sentence! Radioblogging with Pie Corbett every day at 9.30am. Complete some of the games and writing activities (link on Twitter) Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Look at www.oxfordowl.co.uk for new books to read and try some of the activities too. Complete some of the Literacy work on Education City, either Capital Letters or Full Stops folder.
Numeracy	 Use a clock to tell the time to the hour eg 5 to 9, 20 to 3 etc Measure the length of objects inside and outside your house in centimetres using your ruler or a measuring tape. Write your answers in your jotter. Practise tables using Hit the Button on www.topmarks.co.uk Complete Measure activities on Education City – remember to click on CLASSWORK.
ICT	 Type up your prayer to Our Lady. Change the font, size and colour. Add a picture of Mary or flowers to decorate it. Use Google Interlands to learn more about internet safety.
RE	 Children's Liturgy as we can't go to Mass https://youtu.be/dK3wSdrsz1s Write a prayer to Our Lady. Thursday is Ascension Thursday. Find out what happened on this day and write about it in your jotter.
PE	 Use PE with Joe, Cosmic Kids Yoga or Jumpstart Johnny to do PE indoors. Play outdoors as much as you can.
Other things to do	 Today is the start of National Smile Month. Find out more about the different types of teeth you have, how to brush your teeth properly and lots of other activities on www.dentalhealth.org/national-smile-month Take some paper outside and do a landscape drawing or sketch some pretty flowers. Watch Newsround and choose some BBC Bitesize programmes to watch. Drama: 'Hot-seating' Pretend you are 'The Old Lady who Lived in a Shoe'. Sit on the 'Hot-Seat' and ask an adult to ask you questions e.g. How did you to come to live in a shoe? What do you like about living in a shoe?
