Primary 3 – Please find below some activities to do this week, $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ June.

Literacy	 This week's spelling words are: Capital Letters: gym, mystery, pyramid, cygnet, crystal, rhythm; Full Stops: see, been, three, green, sleep Learn how to spell your words by saying each word then jump for each letter, shouting them out as you jump. Make a poster showing your favourite and least favourite smells, sights, sounds, textures and tastes. Read a book, magazine or online story for 20 minutes each day. Why not read J K Rowling's new book The Ickabog published online? Write a new blurb for your book to encourage other children to read it. Complete some of the Literacy work on Education City, either Capital Letters or Full Stops folder.
Numeracy	 Use a clock to tell the time to and past the hour eg 5 to 9, 20 past 4 etc Bake with an adult. Weigh out and measure the ingredients accurately. Practise tables using Hit the Button on www.topmarks.co.uk or the activities in your Classwork folder in Education City. Complete the Measure and Shape activities on Education City – remember to click on CLASSWORK. There are new activities this week!
ICT	 Coding: www.code.org click LEARN AT HOME and choose a different one of the activities to do. I know this is new, just try your best! Sumdog - Maths, Spelling and Grammar activities Google Interlands
RE	 Children's Liturgy for Pentecost Sunday as we can't go to Mass https://youtu.be/Xd3T1BU9eIM Draw a picture to show what happened on Pentecost Sunday.
PE	 Use PE with Joe, Cosmic Kids Yoga, Jumpstart Johnny or Go Noodle to do PE indoors. Play outdoors as much as you can.
Other things to do	 Personal Project for June. Choose something you are interested in or something you want to learn more about and create a fact file/poster/power point about it. It could be about a sports person, pop singer, movie star; or space, dinosaurs, cars; or about your favourite sport, hobby, food; or a particular country you have been to or would like to visitanything! Watch Newsround and choose some BBC Bitesize programmes to watch. Practise Numbers to 20 and Greetings in French STEM Challenge: Can you build a raft or boat that can transport 10 pennies using recycled materials from around your home? You can test this out in the bath or sink.
