- Identify features on a map eg river, hill, trees, buildings, roads, ponds
- Differentiate between land and sea on a simple map
- Follow a simple "plan" showing the route taken and am able to identify landmarks on that route (Ladybird Leaves Home, Going on a Bear Hunt)
