Write a story with your spelling words in it and draw a picture to go with it.	<p>Crossword spelling</p> <p>Create a crossword for your spelling words by creating clues for your words.</p>
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<p>Podcast Spelling</p> <p>Record an opinion piece on the computer using your spelling words. Your podcast may end up on the internet. You can edit your podcast and add music and sound effects</p>	<p>Root Words</p> <p>Find and write the root word for each of your spelling words</p>
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<p>Flash Cards</p> <p>Using cardboard create flash cards of your spelling words to use in a game of snap or go fish. Note: When you have finished get someone at home to test you on your words <i>Make sure you are neat!</i></p>	<p>Make your own TASK CARD</p> <p>Think of an activity you can do to help you learn your spelling and create a task card. <i>Add it to the spelling activities tub!</i></p>
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<p>Dictionary Meanings</p> <p>Find the dictionary meaning for each of your spelling words. Write the meanings in your book. Indicate if the word is a noun, verb, adjective or adverb. (The answer is next to the word in the dictionary. If it isn't have a go yourself.)</p>	<p>Spelling</p> <p>Draw your spelling words in bubble writing and outline your words with different colours making your spelling words look like a rainbow.</p>

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<p>Comic Strip</p> <p>Create your own comic strip using your spelling words. If it is good I will put it on the language wall.</p>	<p>Alphabetical Order</p> <p>Write your words in alphabetical order and write how many syllables the word has next to it.</p>
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<p>Spelling Sentences</p> <p>Write a sentence for every spelling word in your list. Make your sentences interesting and make sure <b>all</b> spelling in your sentences is correct.</p>	<p>Alliteration</p> <p>Create funny and clever alliterations for your spelling words. Make sure they have at least 3 words with the same starting sound and they <b>make sense!</b></p>
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<p>Rainbow Spelling</p> <p>Draw your spelling words in bubble writing and outline your words with different colours making your spelling words look like a rainbow.</p>	<p>Word Search</p> <p>Create a word search with your spelling words</p>
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<p>Advertisements</p> <p>Create an advertisement (poster) promoting a product but make sure you use your spelling words!</p>	<p>Spelling Facts</p> <p>Write 10 facts about your spelling words. You can research your words if you like. A word can have more than one fact, but you need at least one for each!</p>

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<p>Storybook Challenge</p> <p>Write a story designed for the students of P1. You have to use your spelling words and pictures to help the children understand the story.</p>	<p>Antonyms</p> <p>Write as many antonyms you can think of or find for each of your words. Remember ANTONYMS are words that mean the opposite.</p>
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<p>Haiku</p> <p>Write a HAIKU using your spelling words. A HAIKU is a Japanese Poem usually about Nature. It has three lines. The first line must contain 5 syllables, the second 7 syllables and the third 5 syllables. Your poem doesn't have to be about nature but needs to include at least one of your spelling words.</p>	<p>Graphic Design</p> <p>Write your words in a graphic design of your choice. You can put your words in hearts, write like graffiti, robot words, draw a picture using your words instead of lines etc...</p>
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<p>Alphabetical Order</p> <p>Put your spelling words in alphabetical order.</p>	<p>Arty Spelling</p> <p>Cut out letters from newspapers and magazines and spell your spelling words. Stick your words in your book. Be neat!</p>
